Speed Limit Proposals

Tattenhall & District Parish Council has been in discussion with Cheshire West and Chester Council over the possibility of introducing speed limit reductions in Tattenhall.

When considering changes to existing speed limits, Cheshire West and Chester Council uses current guidance produced by the Department for Transport (DfT) to provide a consistent approach, help with compliance and make roads safer. Key factors are taken into account such as mean traffic speed, collision injury history, the level of use by pedestrians and cyclists and the characteristics of the road.

The review recommended a new speed limit on the following lengths of road, as indicated on the plan overleaf:

- Chester Road (from A41 to Gatesheath Lane) - 50mph.
- Chester Road (from Gatesheath Lane to 30mph speed limit) – 40mph.
- Frog Lane – 50mph
- Gatesheath Lane – 40mph.
- Newton Lane – 40mph.
- Red Lane – 50mph.
- Rocky Lane – 40mph
- Tattenhall Road (from 30mph speed limit to Newton Lane) – 40mph.
- Tattenhall Road (from Newton Lane to Red Lane) – 50mph.

It is important that the enforcement authorities are in support of such changes and Cheshire Constabulary's position is that they would not support any change in speed limit that does not conform to DfT guidance. The proposals have the support of Cheshire Police and requests for speed limits lower than those proposed would not be supported.
