

## **Terms of Reference Neighbourhood Plan Review Committee**

The main points for consideration:

Members (with voting rights) appointed by the Council should either:

- be a Parish Councillor
- a resident of the designated area
- work in the designated area
- represent an agreed community group in the designated area
- represent an agreed land-owner in the designated area
- represent an agreed business in the designated area

Consultants

- to be appointed by the Parish Council, after 3 tenders
- to have a defined role
- have no voting right

Numbers (not in the draft)

- Maximum
- Proportion resident in the designated area
- Proportion Parish Councillors

Members of the public

- Members of the public have a right to attend a committee, as per Standing Orders.
- The Council may decide whether members of the public may participate.
- Members of the public would not have the right to vote.
