

Notes of Tattenhall Neighbourhood Plan Review Working Group
Discussion with Cheshire Community Action
Held virtually via Zoom
13th June 2024

The meeting discussed how to undertake the public consultation and that the Group had been advised to carry out the public consultation before the Reg. 14 consultation.

It was agreed the Group needs a strategic approach as to how to carry out the consultation to get the maximum number of responses, noting the consultation should be proportionate to the changes being proposed.

The consultation needs to confirm the changes proposed and ask for any other comments while having the whole Plan available for review.

It was agreed to publicise the consultation at the Church Fete in July.

A flyer will be distributed to every home in the Plan area with links to online information and survey and advertising the drop-in session in early September.

It was agreed to start work on creating the final or published version of the Plan, noting further amendments might be required after the consultations.

It was noted the Design Code document also needs to be included in the consultation.

It was discussed it would be worth meeting with representatives of Transition Tattenhall to discuss their comments rather than waiting for the consultation.

It was agreed the Clerk would contact ONH regarding costings to complete the Plan review and on getting the Plan into a publishable version.
