Informal Consultation Responses

It was noted the Plan is now up to draft 9.7. It was explained that the sections written in red had been added to the Plan as a result of the consultation.

It was noted that point 8.5 had been added to the Plan as result of the consultation response from Transition Tattenhall.

It was discussed that the Leah Coney from ONH the consultants who are supporting the Group had highlighted that where Local Plans are 'older' and considered out of date their policies have reduced weight in planning and that then reduces the weight of policies in the Neighbourhood plan which refer to those local plan policies.

As such alternative wording had been suggested to overcome this issue.

It was discussed that this was not a change to the policy as it would just define the policy rather than referencing the CW&C policy. It was not known if this would trigger a referendum.

The wording and information had been forwarded to Catherine Morgetroyd at CW&C to comment on. It was agreed to take no further action until she has responded and then review what action is to be take.

Next Steps

It was agreed the Group would meet again depending on the response from CW&C. It was confirmed a Extraordinary Parish Council meeting has been scheduled for Monday 2nd December for Council agree the Plan go out to Reg. 14 consultation and delegate authority to the Clerk to make any necessary non-material changes to the Plan.
