It was noted if this project is taken forward by the Parish Council the Youth Council can promote this scheme via Instagram and take part in discussion about the scheme.

It was agreed that the Youth Council would like to be involved with promoting the creation of a MUGA (multi use games area) in Tattenhall. It was agreed a MUGA would be well used especially by people playing football.

Elf Trail

The Councillors agreed to create an Elf for the Christmas Elf Trail to promote the Youth Council. Anna agreed to email the Clerk information on using # effectively.
