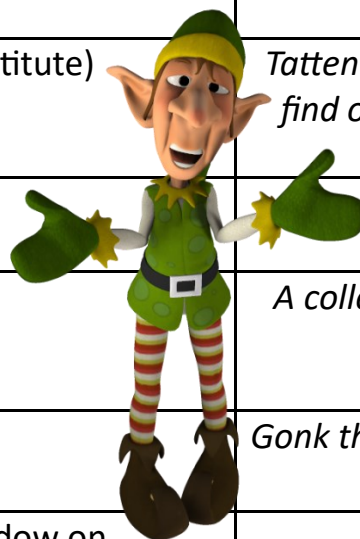

Poppy	8 Flacca Court	<i>A little Elf who has popped up to say hello!</i>

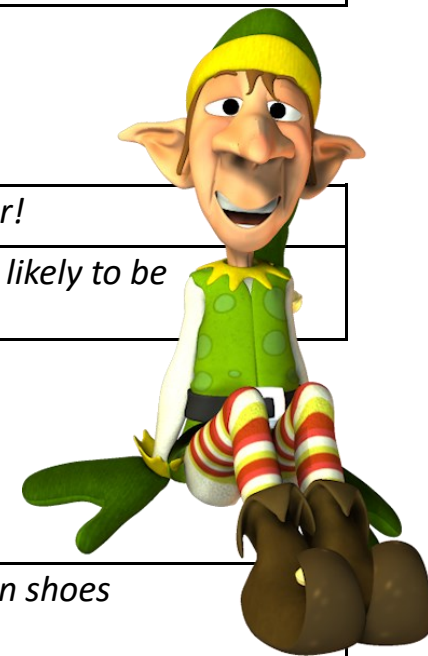

Isolation Elf	Village Surgery (Surgery window)	<i>Poorly little chap in his isolation bubble</i>

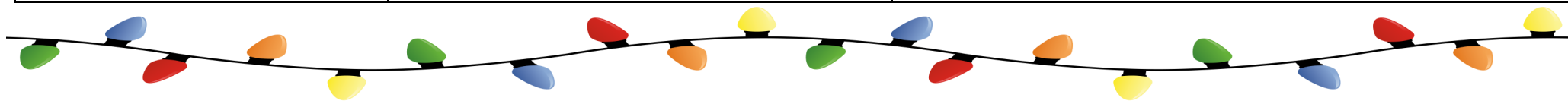
Park Avenue
